15" STEEL CABLE LOCKS

These are inexpensive, basic devices (like a bicycle lock) that fit any firearm. They are required by Federal law to be given out with every handgun purchase in the United States. Some states also require that they are also given out with long gun purchases. DAC and FSDC are two of the more common manufacturers.



KEYED OR COMBINATION TRIGGER LOCKS

Trigger locks are designed to fit most firearms. They prevent unauthorized access when inserted and locked into the trigger guard. FSDC and Master Lock have readily available options.



LOCKBOXES

There are a wide variety of sizes, locking technology, and price-points available in this category. When reviewing options, you will want to consider how many handguns and firearm accessories, or additional items will be stored in each box, as well as where you plan to keep the box. Common and reliable manufacturers in this category include Bulldog, Hornady, SnapSafe, and Vaultek.



FIREARM SAFES

Again, there are many options in terms of size, technology, and price-points here.
